The effect – 45 years ago – of a visit to the Vincentius homes in Jakarta

- Since 1946 friar Winand Divendal ofm worked at the Vincentius children’s homes in Jakarta.
- In 1976 his brother and sister-in-law visited him in Jakarta.
- On March 17th 1977 the Dutch Charity Foundation “Panti Asuhan” was established to help children in the Vincentius children’s homes in Indonesia on a durable base.
- Aid was given for life support (food and housing), education and on project basis.
- Meanwhile a hard core of sponsors has grown around the Charity Foundation “Panti Asuhan”.



Inspired and enthusiastic board members

- In the beginning the Board consisted of merely family members of the Divendal family.
- New voluntary board members outside the family were also always easily found in all their enthusiasm: 4th generation Board Members.
- Mayor Maarten Divendal of Municipality De Ronde Venen is the patron of the Foundation since April 2017.
- Every year the Charity Foundation receives about €50.000,- from their sponsors and occasionally a legacy increases the income of the Foundation. This means a spend of more than €2.5 mio since the establishment of the foundation.

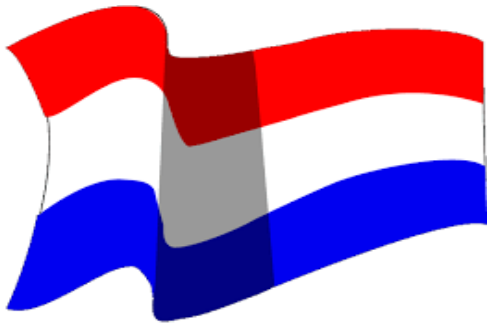
